# Trip Overview

- Location: Kenya, Africa (Maasai Region)
- Length: 10 -14 days
- Stay: Our camp in the bush (where we live)
- Team Size: Varies

Each trip is prayerfully led and may look a little different, but everything we do is centered around sharing the Gospel.



# What You'll Be Part Of

- Evangelism in remote villages
- Open-air crusades and church services
- Ministry in schools and communities
- Working alongside local pastors and leaders
- Children's ministry and outreach
- Safari experience in the Maasai Mara

You'll go to places where many have never heard the name of Jesus - and be part of changing that.



# Life at Camp: Nameelok Enkare Camp

You will be staying at our camp in the bush - this is where we live and do ministry.

This is not a hotel experience. It is simple, safe, and meaningful.

- Shared tent accommodations
- Beds, linens, and basic necessities provided
- Meals prepared and served at camp
- Limited electricity
- Simple shower and bathroom facilities

This environment is part of what makes the trip so impactful.

It removes distractions and allows you to fully engage in what God is doing.



# Heart Posture & Culture

You are stepping into a different culture, and that is part of the beauty of this trip.

Come ready to:

- Serve, not be served
- Learn, not compare
- Love people as they are

We are not there to change a culture - we are there to share Jesus. Flexibility is key. Plans may change, days may look different than expected, and that's okay. Some of the most powerful moments happen in the unexpected.



# Dress & Conduct

Out of respect for the culture and to avoid offense.

## **Women:**

- Required to wear skirts for the duration of the trip
  - (including ministry, travel days in Kenya, safari, and outings)
- Skirts should be modest, loose, and below the knee
- Shoulders should be covered
- Avoid tight-fitting or revealing clothing
- Leggings/slips may be worn underneath if needed

## **Men:**

- Modest, casual clothing (jeans, khakis, t-shirts, button-up)
- Pants recommended
- Shoulders covered

## **Everyone:**

- Dress modestly
- Represent Christ well in conduct and attitude
- Tattoos should be covered whenever possible out of respect for the local culture
- No alcohol permitted

# Travel Requirements

## **Passport**

- You must have a valid passport
- It should not expire within 6 months of travel

## **ETA (Electronic Travel Authorization)**

- Must be completed online prior to travel
- Website:
- Cost: Approximately \$35
- This is not covered by FireWind Ministries

## **Flights**

- Flights are covered and coordinated by FireWind Ministries

We will guide you through the entire process!

# Trip Cost

The cost of each trip can vary depending on timing and logistics. Once you are accepted onto a team, we will provide you with the exact cost and payment schedule.

FireWind Ministries Covers:

- Flights
- Lodging
- Transportation in Kenya
- Ministry Expenses
- Travel Insurance

You Responsible For:

- Passport
- ETA (e-visa) - Approximately \$35
- Personal Spending (Snacks, souvenirs, etc.)

# Payments

After being accepted onto a team:

- A deposit will be required to secure your spot
- Remaining payments will be made in scheduled installments leading up to the trip
- All payments details and due dates will be clearly communicated

We encourage each team member to pray and trust God as they prepare financially for the trip.

- Save personally
- Send support letters
- Receive support from family, friends, or their church

All payments and documents will be managed through your personal trip portal.

# Trip Portal & Registration

Once you are accepted onto a team, you will receive access to your personal trip portal.

Through your portal, you will be able to:

- Make payments towards your trip
- Download important documents (itinerary, forms, etc.)
- Upload any required paperwork
- Stay up to date with trip details and communication

Each team member will have their own login and trip account, making it easy to stay organized and prepared leading up to departure.

# What to Bring (Overview)

You do not need to bring:

- Bedding
- Towels
- Pillows

You will need:

- Modest clothing (skirts for women)
- Durable, closed-toe shoes suitable for the bush
- Wide-brim hat (very important for sun protection)
- Bible & Notebook
- Flashlight or Headlamp
- Toiletries
- Any personal medications
- Travel/Charging Adapter (Kenya uses different outlets)

# FAQ'S

## Is it safe? 01

Yes.

You will be with us at all times. Our camp is secured and guarded, and we take every precaution to ensure safety.

## What about animals? 02

You will hear and possibly see wildlife such as zebras, hyenas, and more. While this is part of the experience, you will be safe at camp and during travel.

## What is the food like? 03

Meals are prepared by a trained chef and served at camp. We provide clean drinking water throughout your stay. We will guide you on what is safe to eat and drink while in Kenya.

## What is ministry like? 04

Ministry includes:

- Preaching the Gospel in villages
- Sharing testimonies
- Praying for the sick
- School ministry
- Conferences & Crusades
- Being the hands and feet of Jesus

There is a place for everyone to be involved.

## Do I need ministry experience? 05

## Will we go on safari? 06
